SINGAPORE DEFENCE TECHNOLOGY SUMMIT SPEAKERS CALL ON PRIME MINISTER LEE HSIEN LOONG

- 1. Eight global leaders in technology met with Singapore Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong at the Istana on 28 June 2018. There was a good exchange of views on emerging trends and opportunities arising from rapid technological changes.
